Western Carolina, the destruction's epicenter, is mainly inaccessible by road. We are partnering with these two organizations to deliver vital supplies by air.

Drop-off locations from across North Carolina are joining in this effort. Currently, this group is focused on servicing Watauga County and the Boone, Banner Elk, and Blowing Rock areas.

Operation Airdrop does not provide search and rescue services. Their primary mission is to deliver essential supplies to communities affected by disasters.

Flight operations will begin on Monday, September 30th, 2024. They are calling on volunteer pilots to get ready to deploy! Multiple destinations are set, with Asheville Regional Airport (AVL) being our largest and most prominent and other locations (with and without airport access) in need.

For those delivering ground donations, our drop-off location is at the Walmart near Concord NC Regional Airport. Huge thanks to [Miracle Movers](#), who will be providing trucks to help transport the supplies!

Pilots: Get ready to deploy! Sign up using the link above with Operation Airdrop to fly essential resources to those in need. Great news for pilots: Operation Airdrop has secured a \$0.75 per gallon fuel discount for those flying under the Operation Airdrop relief mission. Just mention our mission to the FBO to get your discount.
